**2018-2019 REQUIRED COURSES FOR FRESHMEN**

**ENGLISH:**

1 credit required (one year)	<i>Student is automatically pre-registered for <b>English 9</b> until Advanced Course Request form is submitted or Intervention Specialist recommends a different course.</i>
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**MATH:**

1 credit required (one year)	<i>Student is automatically pre-registered for the appropriate math course based upon the 8<sup>th</sup> grade math class.</i>
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**SCIENCE:**

1 credit required (one year)	<i>Student is automatically pre-registered for <b>Physical Science</b> until Advanced Course Request Form is submitted or Intervention Specialist recommends a different course. <b>Biology</b> (Prerequisite: Algebra 1, Teacher signature <b>not required</b>) <b>Honors Biology</b> (Prerequisite: Algebra 1 AND teacher signature <b>required</b>)</i>
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**SOCIAL STUDIES**

1 credit required (one year)	<i>Student will automatically be pre-registered for the <b>Global Studies I</b> (semester 1) and <b>Global Studies II</b> (semester 2).</i>
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**HEALTH**

1/2 credit required (one semester)	<i>Student will automatically be pre-registered for <b>Health</b>. Students intending to complete Health in summer school must have a transcript showing credit for a Health course submitted to the School Counseling Office <b>no later than the week before the school year begins</b>.</i>
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**PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

1/4 credit required (one semester)	<i>Student will automatically be pre-registered for <b>P.E.</b> until a signed P.E. Waiver Form is submitted. Students intending to complete P. E in summer school must have a transcript showing credit for a P.E. course submitted to the School Counseling Office.</i>
