School Fees and Instructional Materials (Board Policy 6152) School fees for the 2019-2020 school year are \$55.00 per student. Fees are due at the beginning of the school year. School fees are used for the annual purchase of consumable items (i.e. workbooks) and software subscriptions for individual students. Payments may be made using our online payment system on the district website: www.bwls.net, a credit card transaction at school, or by sending a check to school. Invoices will be sent on a monthly basis. Until fees are paid, students may not participate in Eagle Extensions. School fees are waived for those students who qualify for Free Lunch. Those students who qualify for Reduced Lunch will pay \$27.50 per student. Please contact Mrs. Wolfe in the office with questions.
