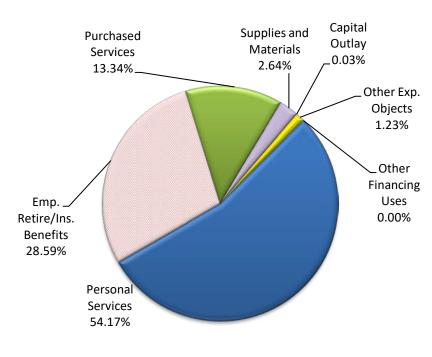

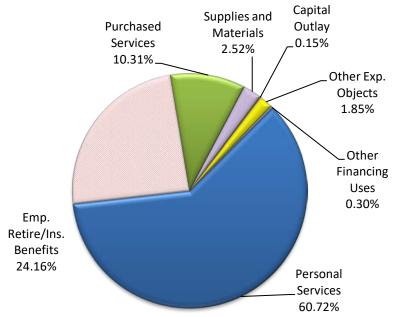




EST. GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES FY20 \$44,709,522

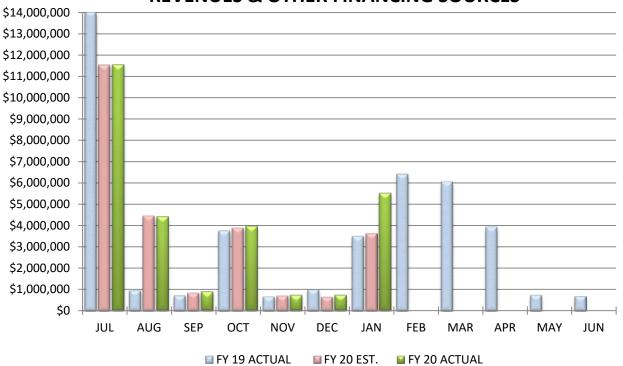

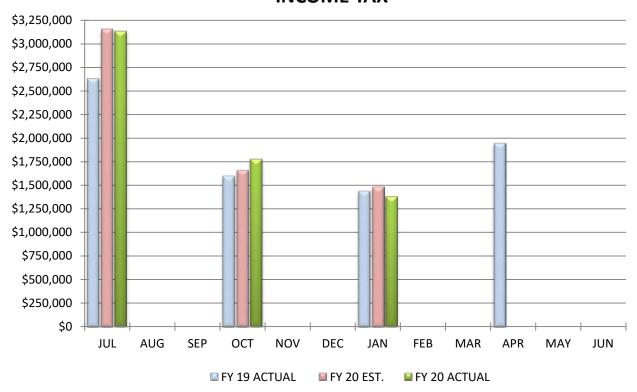

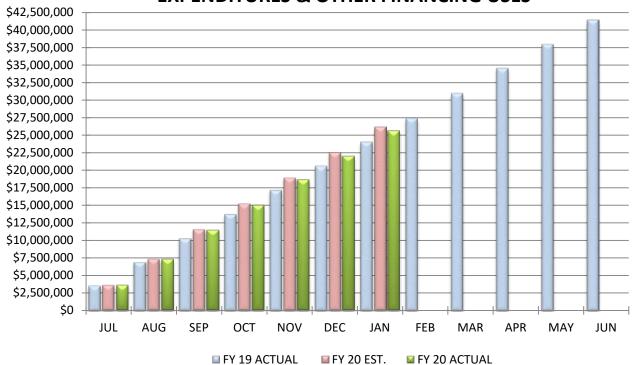
COMMENTS:

COMPARISON OF TOTAL YEAR-TO-DATE EXPENDITURES & OTHER FINANCING USES



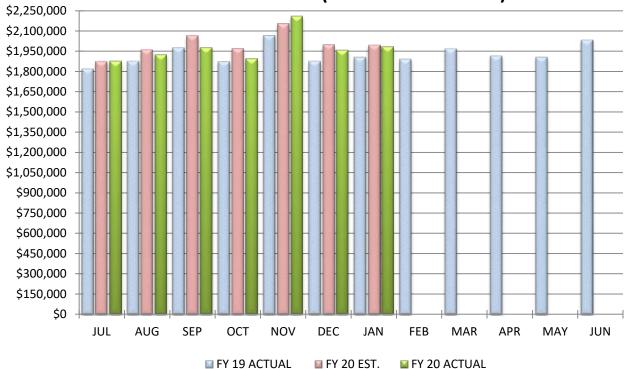

We will continue to monitor the trending of wages but believe this trend is due to realized savings from hiring individuals with slightly lower experience levels than our historic trend as well as not filling some positions, we had orginally budgeted for.

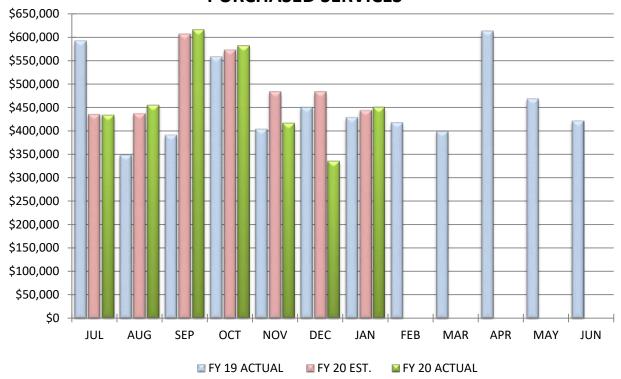

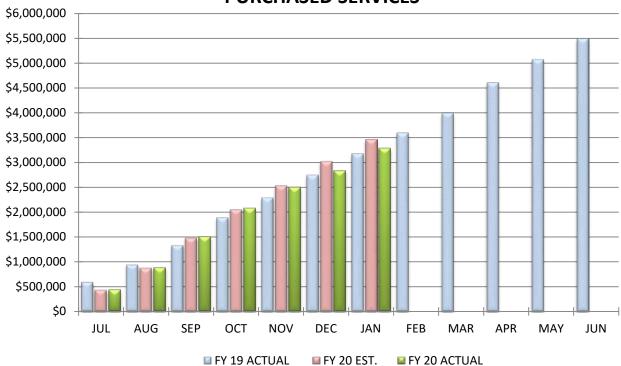

COMMENTS: With lower wages than anticipated, we are also seeing wage-related benefit, such as retirement and Medicare also coming in under estimates. Further, with modifications made to our 2020 insurance plan, we noticed a decrease in participation in the district insurance plan of around 6-7% for 2020. These factors have caused our benefit costs to be lower than originally estimated at this point in the year. Monthly expenditures were over estimates due to employer contributions to HSA accounts made in January. We will continue to monitor this expenditure line in the coming months to see current trends continue in the coming months.

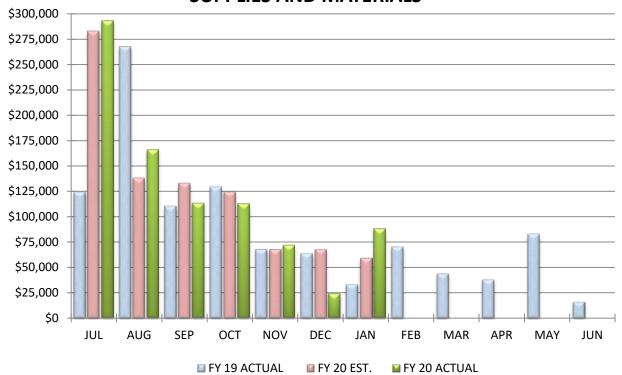

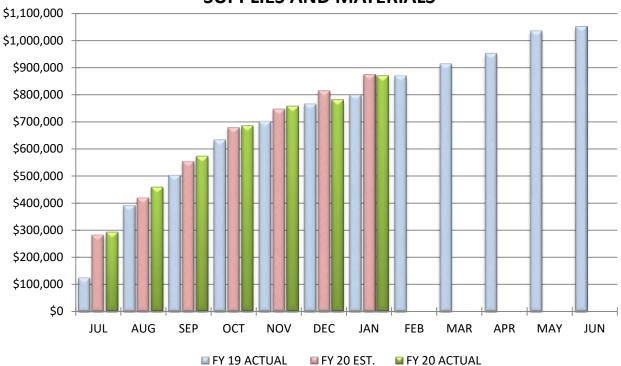

In addition, we have made some prepayments for services provided through the Educational Services Center that have reduce monthly costs. Additionally, our state deductions for community school and special education scholarships are lower at this point in the year compared to previous years. With our more mild winter utilities are currently coming in under budget also. These factors are contributing to variances in in our purchased services. We will continue to monitor this expenditure line and anticipate being on target with annual estimates as the year continues.

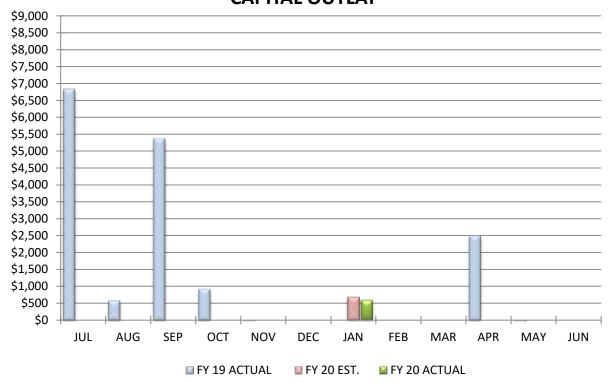

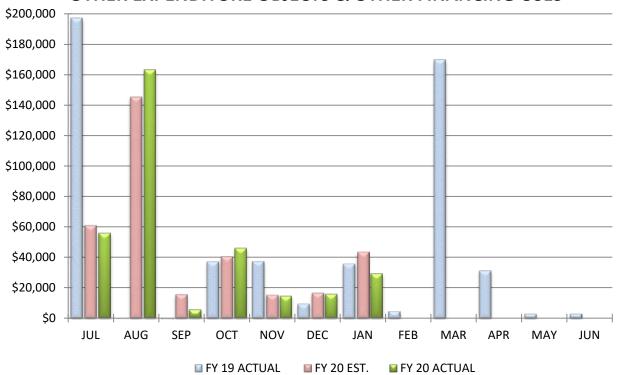
