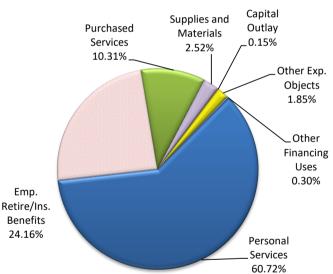




EST. GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES FY20 \$44,709,522

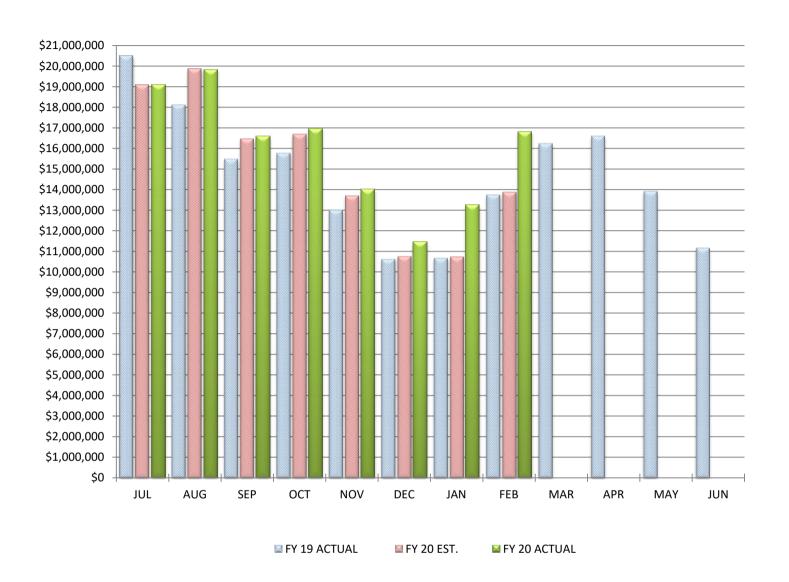

COMPARISON OF MONTHLY ENDING CASH BALANCES



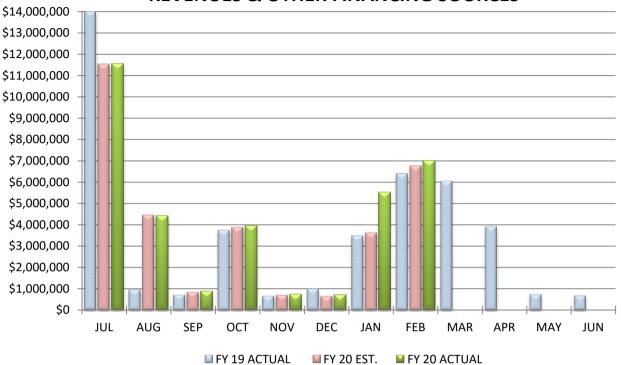

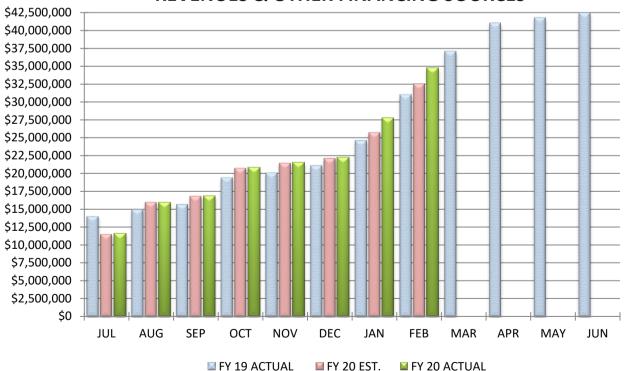

COMPARISON OF TOTAL YEAR-TO-DATE REVENUES & OTHER FINANCING SOURCES



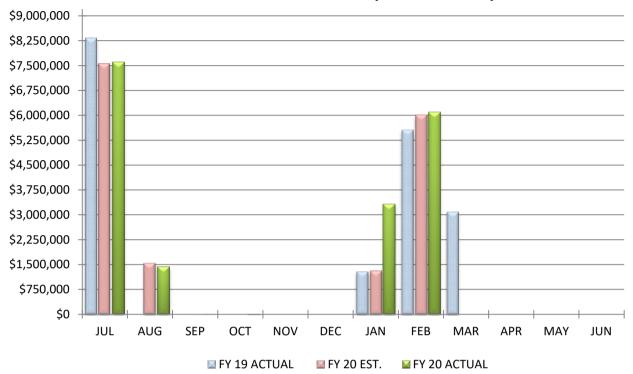

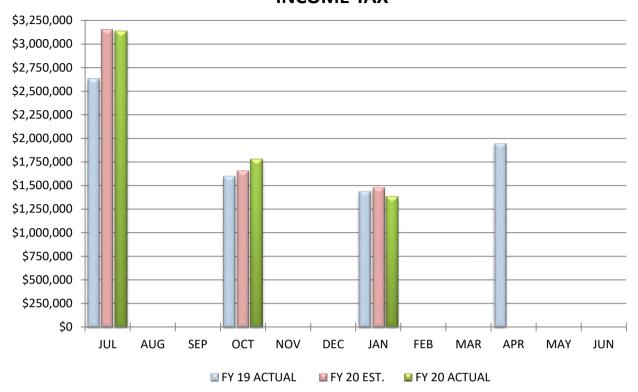

COMPARISON OF TOTAL YEAR-TO-DATE INCOME TAX



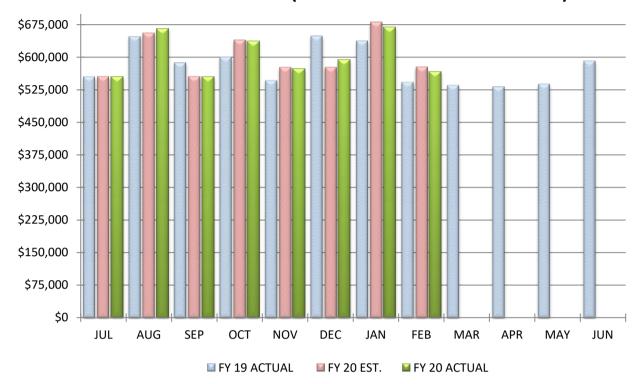

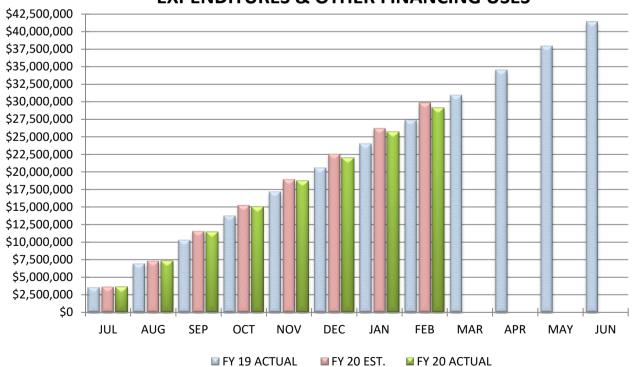
COMMENTS:

Monthly collections were in line with estimates and annual variance amounts remain positive due to higher interest income and special assessment taxes on the Sunbury Mills retail development area compared to prior years. We are on pace to meet our annual estimated amount. While interest income is only a small portion of our revenue sources, it has aided to a positive variance in the resources line. In light of current economic volatility, we will need to reevaluate if anticipated future revenue projects from interest income is still accurate.

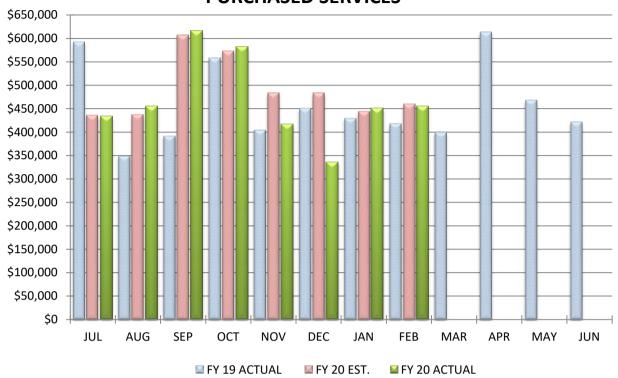

COMMENTS: With lower wages than anticipated, we are also seeing wage-related benefit, such as retirement and Medicare also coming in under estimates. Further, with modifications made to our 2020 insurance plan, we noticed a decrease in participation in the district insurance plan of around 6-7% for 2020. These factors have caused our benefit costs to be lower than originally estimated at this point in the year. We will monitor this expenditure line to see if current trends continue in the coming months.

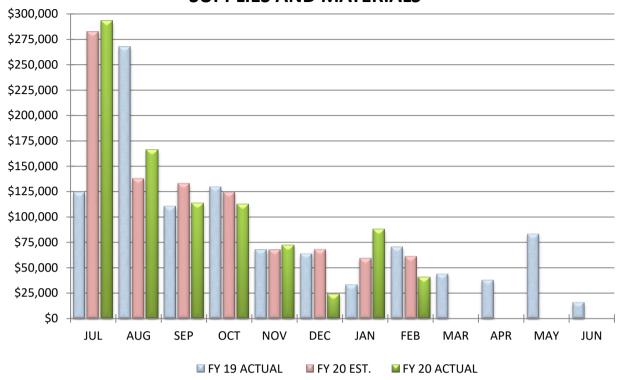

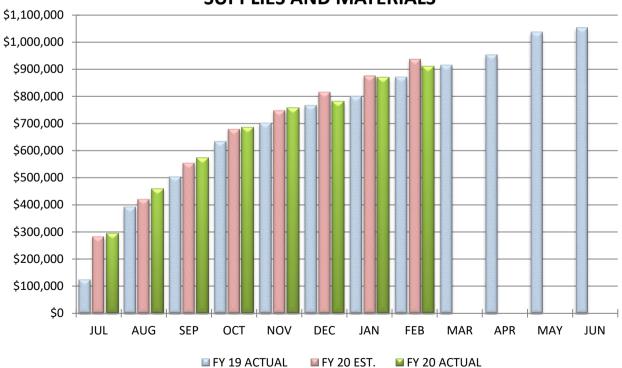

COMMENTS: Purchased service expenditures are an area subject to timing differences each year depending on when the service is provided. We were on target with monthly estimates and continue to have a favorable variance for the fiscal year. With our more mild winter utilities are currently coming in under budget and the timing of our ESC of Central Ohio payments have allowed us to be under annual estimates at this point in the year. With updates in our state foundation deductions part way through the year, we have seen a large increase in our special needs Autism and John Peterson scholarships, which will increase our costs in the coming months. We will continue to monitor this expenditure line, and overall, we anticipate being on target with annual estimates as the year continues.

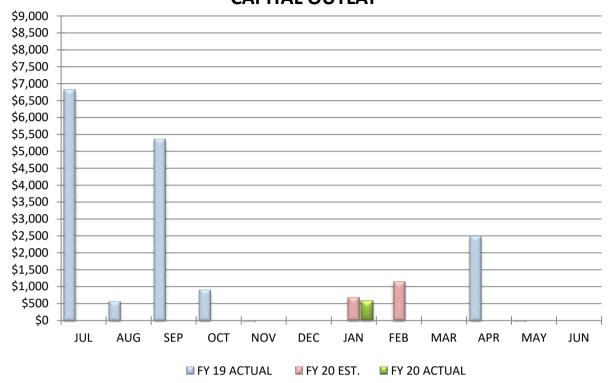

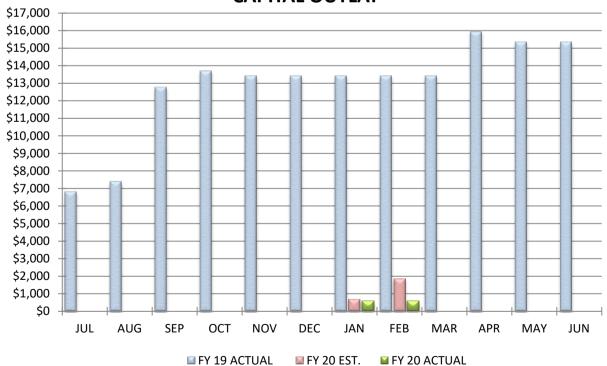

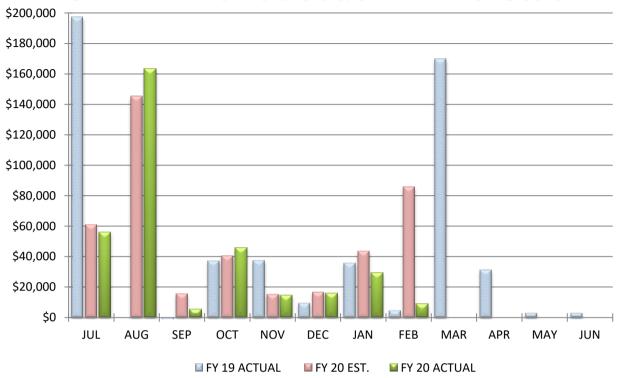
