### Prescription Help

About the program: This is a prescription assistance program. There is a \$15 service charge per medication per month. There is no application fee. You qualify if: You earn \$30,000 or less per year as a single individual, or \$50,000 or less as a couple. • You do not have prescription insurance coverage, but may have health insurance. You may have a discount prescription card and still qualify. • You do not participate in Medicaid • You are experiencing a financial hardship To apply:

Ohio's Best Rx is a prescription discount card eligible to Ohioans of any age. It includes almost all brand name and generic drugs. There is no application or enrollment fee. This state sponsored program is run by the Ohio Department of Aging. There are more than 2,700 participating pharmacies as well as a mail order option. Ohio's Best Rx can also be used during Medicaid Part D "doughnut hole" when prescription costs are 100% out of pocket.
