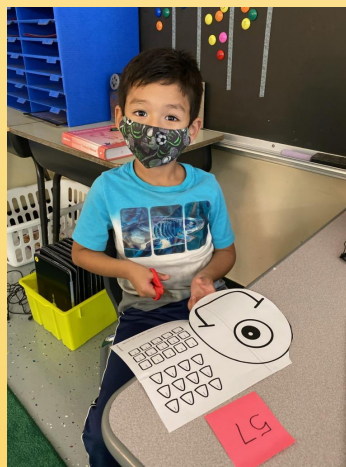
If your child is out sick, please let us know. Either call the building or complete [this form online](#). You do not need to do both.

When bringing your child to school, have your child ready to exit the vehicle-coat and mask on! This helps keep the line moving.

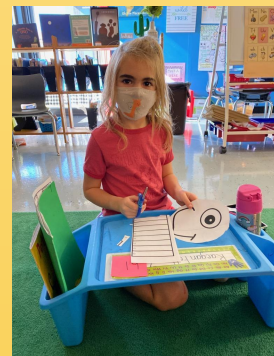
